
Joe Johnson's Beatle Brunch Turns 30!

On May 29th Beatle Brunch will broadcast episode #1,561 entering year 31 with a retrospective show featuring some special guests and memories of the timeline of **The Beatles** during the 30-year run of **The Brunch**.

"In 1992 I bought a new car with an in-dash CD player and took a road trip listening to a stack of Beatles CDs. It was then that I longed for a weekly radio show on **The Beatles**, but there was none, so I produced a demo and played it for my Director of Programing, Rick Peters and he liked it and we began playing it on Majic 102.7 in Miami".

MOST MEMORABLE BEATLE BRUNCH INTERVIEW?

"Interviewing Paul McCartney in person in Tampa in 2005. He was incredibly kind and generous with his time. We spoke one-on-one for 25-minutes. I'll never forget it"

MOST TENSE BEATLE BRUNCH INTERVIEW?

"When I was about to meet and interview Sir Paul McCartney in Tampa in 2005, I could NOT get my mini-disc player to record after testing it over and over before he came into the room. I was really freaking out and Paul was looking at me, so I punched the recorder and luckily it began recording. Whew!"

MOST POIGNANT MOMENT IN BEATLE BRUNCH HISTORY?


"I was invited to be on CNN live worldwide with Wolf Blitzer the day George Harrison passed, November 29, 2001."

WHAT WAS YOUR FAVORITE BEATLE BRUNCH EPISODE?

"I once produced a show called 'Guess the Feature", where every song in the show had one thing in common: each had a one-word title: "Rain", "Wait" "Help!", "Girl", how many can YOU think of?"
